

Information about the entry 2022

On Saturday November 19 2022, Sinterklaas will come back to Duivendrecht. He will arrive by boat at the Duivendrechtsekade at 12:30. Everyone is more than welcome to greet and celebrate Sinterklaas and his Pieten coming to our little town. Once he has arrived, we will march through the town together towards the Dorpsplein.

The route of the walk will go from the Rijksweg, to Kruidenommegang, through the Zonnehof and the primary schools, before we head towards the Dorpsplein. From approximately 14:00, everyone is welcome to greet Sinterklaas in the Dorpshuis. The children will get some nice treats and a present from Sinterklaas and his Pieten.

This is made possible by the gifts from residents, companies and entrepreneurs. This is why volunteers from the foundation will go from house to house in the week of the 24th of October between 17:00 until 19:00 to collect money in Duivendrecht and Diemen Biesbosch. Thanks to the gifts from the people in town it is possible for us to make the arrival of Sinterklaas a true event (for more information about the collection week, click [here](#)).


Gluten free and sensory-friendly

It is required to make a reservation for the sensory friendly meeting with Sinterklaas because it takes some preparation and it has a limited number of places. Gluten free Piet is coming to Duivendrecht

During the celebratory day with Sinterklaas in Duivendrecht, there will be a Piet that will provide gluten free pepernoten. To make sure that ALL children can enjoy and celebrate this beautiful event, Sinterklaas has decided to ask Grandma-Piet to bake gluten free pepernoten for the children that are intolerant to gluten. Grandma-Piet is recognisable through her walker and a flag from the Dutch Coeliakie Foundation for gluten free pepernoten.

The NCV started a few years ago with Hoofdpiet Monique Stevens and a bunch of eager volunteers to make sure that children that are gluten intolerant can still enjoy the celebrations like any other kid. This year as well. Several towns have a gluten free Pie who, thanks to their sponsor Liberaire, hand out gluten free pepernoten. This year Duivendrecht will also have this option available.

How do you recognise the gluten free Piet?

The gluten free pepernoten are handed out in a special NCV bag, to make sure the delicacy is not mixed with gluten filled pepernoten. Grandma-Piet is the only one handing out these pepernoten, and she is not handing out anything else. She is recognisable through her walker and the little flag of the NCV. Watch out! Maybe you will recognise her...

How does Grandma-Piet recognise you?

After, you can put the colouring page on your Pietenmuts, or your bag, you can make a flag out of it or lift it high up in the air. This way, Grandma-Piet will see you and know that you can only have gluten free pepernoten. Sensory friendly meeting with Sinterklaas

The celebration on November 19 is an event with a lot of 'a lot': a lot of (sometimes loud) music, a lot of happy, exciting Pieten and a lot of children that want to say hello to Sinterklaas, make a picture and get some candy and presents. This will all happen in the gym of the Dorpshuis in Duivendrecht. The celebration that day requires a lot of fantasy and imagination of the children and it turns out to be a day filled with excitement and a lot of stimuli.

For some children, this can be too much, and the day Sinterklaas comes to Duivendrecht is less of a celebration and more of a sensory overload of too many sounds and things to see. For these children, we organise a sensory friendly meeting with Sinterklaas for the very first time.

De sensory friendly meeting with Sinterklaas will take place in a room specifically organised for the situation. The room has a minimal number of celebratory outings and the music will be soft. Sinterklaas and a maximum of two to three Pieten will be in the room (compared to around thirty Pieten during the regular meeting). The children can take place on a seat specifically for them with enough space for a parent or guardian to be with them as well. Sinterklaas will talk to them a bit (think of explaining to them what happened during the walk-through town earlier), or he will read them a story. Afterwards, the children will get a present and some delicacies made by the Pieten. It is also possible to take a picture with Sinterklaas, if the children want to. During this sensory friendly meeting, we will keep note of the needs of children within the autism spectrum, high-sensitivity, anxiety or what other reason that can cause a sensory overload.

The sensory friendly meeting with Sinterklaas will take place on November 19 starting at 16:00 and will be around fifteen minutes long. It is required to make a reservation for this time, due to the number of places we have and the preparations for the small event. There is a maximum of 25 children that can be there during this small meeting with Sinterklaas. If there are more children who want to be there during this time, we will look at the possibilities for a second round.
